

Standard Terms and Conditions

Flight Training

The following terms and conditions apply to all aspects of flight training offered by Aeolus Aviation.

1. It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of and to have read that part of the company's Training and Operations Manual and its Standard Operating Procedures that apply to his or her training.
2. Aeolus Aviation reserves the right to cancel, either temporarily or permanently and without penalty to Aeolus Aviation, the training of any student who fails to comply with the rules and regulation as laid out in the company's Training and Operations Manual and its Standard Operating Procedures.
3. Aeolus Aviation shall provide appropriate aircraft and qualified instructors for all flight training. It is the sole discretion of Aeolus Aviation as to which aircraft and instructors will be assigned to each student.
4. Aeolus Aviation will hold a student responsible for any damages to any equipment belonging to or used by the company which arises through failure of the student to observe the rules and regulations of the State, E.A.S.A, the company's Training and Operations manual or its Standard Operating Procedures.
5. The student shall make him or herself available in good time for training so as not to delay his or her flight and that of following students. Failure to do so will result in the loss of the training slot and a declaration of a student "no show" as defined in the Standard Operating Procedures.
6. Any further flight training beyond that stated in the course description required by the student to reach a level of performance sufficient to pass the flight skill test will be chargeable at current rates for aircraft and instructor time.
