Description:

This course provides the necessary flight training and flight examination required by E.A.S.A Part F.C.L Class Rating Instructor.

Privileges of the Holder

The privileges of an CRI(A) are to issue, revalidate and renew class or type ratings for non-complex, non high performance aircraft, along with sailplane tow ratings, sea plane ratings, banner towing ratings and aerobatic ratings, when the applicant holds the relevant flight ratings for the class.

Contents:

- 5 Hours flight training for multi-engine aircraft or 3 hours for single engine aircraft
- 2 hours skill test on type with HCAA assigned inspector/examiner
- 25 Hours theoretical class course 'teaching and learning' instruction
- Progress test and in house examination

Material / Equipment provided:

- Printed instructional material
- Flight instruction handbook

Prerequisites:

Minimum Age: 18 years Medical Certificate: Class II

Previous training:

- Shall hold at least the license and ratings for which flight instruction is to be given.
- [For CRI(SEP)] Shall have 300 hours flight experience and 30 hours on type
- [For CRI(MEP)] Shall have 500 hours flight experience and 30 hours on type
