Description:

This course provides the necessary flight training and flight examination required by E.A.S.A Part F.C.L Flight Instructor.

Privileges of the Holder

The privileges of an FI(A) depend heavily upon which other ratings are held and range from PPL training through the complex spectrum of advanced instruction. For details refer to the appropriate EASA literature or contact Aeolus directly.

Contents:

- 30 Hours flight training on single engine aircraft
- 2 hours skill test with HCAA assigned inspector/examiner
- **125 Hours theoretical class course, including 25 hours 'teaching and learning' instruction**
- Progress test and in house examination

Material / Equipment provided:

- Printed instructional material
- Flight instruction handbook

Prerequisites:

Minimum Age : 18 years

Medical Certificate : Class II

Previous training : **(NOTE : these prerequisites represent the MINIMUM requirements to obtain an F.I rating with MINIMUM privileges)**

- PPL(A) or higher
- CPL or ATPL theory credit (NOTE no theory credit is required for an FI(A) providing training for LAPL(A) only)
- 200 hours flight experience of which 150 must be PIC.
- Successful completion of pre-entry flight assessment (2 hours)
