

Instrument Rating SEP to MEP conversion

Description:

This course provides the necessary flight training and flight examination required by E.A.S.A Part F.C.L Instrument Rating on a multi-engine piston aircraft.

Privileges of the Holder

The privileges of an IR(A) holder are to fly aeroplanes under IFR with a minimum decision height of 200 feet (60M).

Contents:

Option 1:

- 5 hours flight training with instructor on IFR trainer on multi-engine aircraft
- 1 hour skill test on Multi-engine aircraft

Option 2:

- 2 hours flight training with instructor on IFR trainer on multi-engine aircraft
- 3 hours synthetic flight training on FNPT-II
- 1 hour skill test on Multi-engine aircraft

Material / Equipment provided:

- Printed instructional material
- Pilots operating handbook

Prerequisites:

Minimum Age : 17 years

Medical Certificate : Class II

Previous training :

- PPL(A) with Night Rating or higher
- 50 Hours cross country as PIC
- Theoretical training : IR theory or ATPL theory
