

Light Aircraft Pilot License

Description:

This course provides the necessary flight training and flight examination required by E.A.S.A Part F.C.L Light aircraft pilot license.

Privileges of the Holder

The privileges of the holder of a LAPL(A) are to act without remuneration as PIC in non-commercial operations on single engine piston aeroplanes-land or TMG with a maximum certified take-off mass of 2000 kg or less, carrying a maximum of 3 passengers, such that there are never more than 4 persons on board the aircraft

Contents:

- 30 Hours flight training in basic training aircraft with flight instructor
Of which a minimum of 15 hours must be dual and a minimum of 6 hours must be supervised solo.
- 2 hours flight examination (skill test)
- LAPL Theoretical course

Material / Equipment provided:

- **Pilot's operating handbook**
- Flight Training manual
- **Pilot's flight bag**
- Log book
- Flight computer (CPR-1 or TPS-1)
- Navigation plotter
- All landing, approach and handling fees
- All paperwork and issuance of license

Prerequisites:

Minimum Age : 14 years to join course, 16 years for first solo, 17 years for license issuance.

Medical Certificate : Class II

Previous training : None required
