

Flight Mentoring (Advanced)

Description:

This course provides the candidate with the opportunity to sharpen and develop their flight, navigation and communication skills in the company of an experienced safety pilot or flight instructor. Candidates for this course will be exposed to more challenging situations than those found during their training such as flights over large expanses of water over the Aegean sea, mountains, unfamiliar destinations and crossing FIR boundaries.

This advanced course is for pilots with a reasonable degree of prior flight experience who wish to advance to the next level. The course will cover flights at night, in bad weather, emergency situations along with advance flight techniques both VFR and IFR.

This is a valuable experience to which all pilots should aspire so as to best advance their airmanship and improve the safety of their flights. Skill learned here will be of great benefit throughout the aviation career of the candidate.

Courses will focus on and be tailored to the specific needs of the candidate.
